- **BNSF Railway Company v. Thomas Clark.** Represented railroad to address a medical examiner's attempt to use statutory procedure to avoid disclosure of key materials; obtained writ of mandate on summary judgment, preventing medical examiner's use of the procedure, which was affirmed by the Washington Supreme Court.
- *Chumbley, et al. v. Snohomish County.* Represented property owner alleging violations relating to permitting of adjacent property's water treatment system in landslide zone; obtained ruling from Court of Appeals holding that Land Use Petition was timely and County was not preempted from enforcing land disturbing activities and critical areas ordinances.
